

OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES LIST

September 20th, 2021

To all members and guests:

Based on the escalating cases of Covid-19 in our province, the Stewart Creek Golf & CC will be moving forward with the implementation of the Restrictions Exemption Program (REP) for the clubhouse facility starting on Monday, September 20th. This includes the restaurant areas, locker rooms and golf shop.

*Mandatory masking indoors remains in effect.

Business Requirements (As mandated by Alberta Health Services)

Businesses that choose to implement the Restrictions Exemption Program <u>must</u> continue to follow indoor mandatory masking requirements, but can operate without capacity or operating restrictions if they require people aged 12 and over to show one of the following:

- proof of vaccination
 - partial vaccination (one dose) accepted September 20 to October 25 if
 received 2 weeks before time of service
 - full vaccination (two doses) required after October 25
- proof of a privately-paid negative PCR or rapid test within 72 hours of service (tests from AHS or Alberta Precision Laboratories not allowed)
- documentation of a medical exemption

Businesses do not need to apply for the program. Audits and enforcement will occur to ensure rules are followed.

The Restriction Exemption Program would not apply to:

- businesses or entities that need to be accessed for daily living
- employees of businesses participating in the program

Booking Tee Times/Reservations:

- All rounds of golf are to be booked in advance. Bookings can be made online at www.stewartcreekgolf.com.
- All booked players will receive an email notification one day prior to the date of play outlining the updated <u>Stewart Creek COVID-19 Operations Procedures</u> for play.
- We ask that all players who have any COVID-19 symptoms to refrain from coming to the golf course. There will be no penalties for cancellations for players exhibiting symptoms.

Golf Course Arrival:

- All golfers who have arrived at the facility will be provided access to their golf cart, practice areas and golf course no earlier than 1 hour before their tee time. This does not include the restaurant or golf shop.
- Carts will be staged at the front entrance of the clubhouse. All carts will have designated player specific cart signs.
- o Following your check in with guest services staff, please park your vehicle.
- For players who have not prepaid for their golf, after adhering to the Restrictions
 Exemption Program inside the front doors of the clubhouse, you can continue on to
 the golf shop to check in. Members and prepaid players are not required to check in at
 the golf shop.
- Guest services staff will be available to assist players with directions to their appropriate golf cart and to provide pertinent daily information to players.
- Players who choose to walk the course can do so by either carrying their bag or by using their own personal push/pull cart or electronic caddy. Access to the golf course is limited to 1 hour before your tee time.

Golf Carts:

- Golf carts can be shared, maximum of two players per cart. Extra carts are available at a cost of \$30 plus gst per cart.
- At the end of their round players will go directly to parking lot to load clubs into their vehicle. Players will drop carts off at the designated cart drop area. Members of the club will be permitted to leave their clubs on the carts so that they can be cleaned and put back into club storage.

Clubhouse Access:

In order to gain entrance into the clubhouse restaurant, locker rooms or golf shop you must adhere to the rules of the Restrictions Exemption Program.

- o Indoor and patio dining is now available.
- Masks must be worn by anyone using the indoor areas of the clubhouse facility when not seated for dining.
- Hand sanitizers have been placed throughout the clubhouse and property for visitor and employee safety.
- Major touch points will be disinfected throughout the day and cleaning schedule maintained for review.
- Access to the member locker rooms will be permitted for members only. Shower facilities
 and fitness area will be open for use and cleaned regularly throughout the day. The
 steam rooms will remain closed. Members should bring their own towel as towel service
 has been temporarily suspended.

Golf Shop:

- o Golf shop is open and available for player check in and retail purchases.
- Masks must be worn by anyone using the indoor areas of the clubhouse facility.
- Credit card and debit card transactions for payment will be the payment forms accepted (cash will not be accepted), use tap feature when applicable.
- Staff will be disinfecting POS area at regular intervals throughout day and will disinfect credit card terminal after every use.
- Merchandise fitting room is available for fittings and will be on a regular cleaning schedule.

Rental Clubs

 Rental clubs are available for use. Rentals can be left on the cart after the round so that they can be cleaned and disinfected.

Driving Range

- Driving range use is limited to players with a tee time and for members who would like to practice.
- Hitting stalls will be spaced with a minimum 2.0m gap between stalls.
- Balls will be stacked in pyramids to allow for "scrape and hit" set up. All range balls will be washed before being stocked on the driving range.
- Members can access the practice area by using an assigned golf cart. Two carts are available on a first come, first served basis.

Short Game Practice Area & Putting Green

- The short game and putting areas are limited to players with a tee time and for players engaged in practice sessions or golf instruction. Use your own golf balls when at either area.
- o Priority for the 1st tee putting green use will be given to players "on deck" to tee off.

1st Tee (Finally I get to peg it!)

- To ensure that your Stewart Creek golfing experience starts off in a phenomenal way, our starter will provide you with pertinent golf course information for your day in the mountains.
- Tee times for Tuesdays will start on hole #10 (golf course reversal) to allow for maintenance practices.

On Course Golf

- Bunker rakes have been placed back on course; however, we do not expect that all players will use them at this time. Treat disturbed areas in bunkers as ground under repair allowing free relief from the disturbed area elsewhere within the bunker.
- Continuous putting and gimmie circles are recommended. At this time flagsticks can be removed while putting.

Food & Beverage

- o Indoor and patio dining are now available.
- The concession at the driving range will be available for take out for guests throughout the day.
- Once a person has picked up their concession F&B item, they are to move away from the concession to either the open area at the back of the driving range or to the 10th tee, should they be playing golf.
- On course food & beverage service at hole #5 will be available at scheduled times throughout the week.

Post Round

 Cart access to the parking lot area will be provided to allow for efficient unloading of clubs and personal items.

Lightning & Thunderstorm Protocol

- During inclement weather the golf course will be cleared of play. Golfers should return to the staging area immediately where they can drop off their cart in the designated area and either head into the clubhouse or their vehicle.
- Once it is safe to return to the golf course a staff member will inform and coordinate players as they return to their previous place on the golf course.

Lessons/Club Fittings/SIM Room

 Lesson programs and club fitting sessions are now operating as normal. The indoor golf simulator can be booked either online or by calling the golf shop.

Member Locker Room

Access to the member locker rooms will be permitted for members only. Shower facilities
and fitness area will be open for use and cleaned regularly throughout the day. The
steam rooms will remain closed. Members should bring their own towel as towel service
has been temporarily suspended.

Member Bag Storage

 Member bag storage is available. The general flow for carts will remain the same. Carts will be staged in front of the clubhouse prior to your round and carts are to be dropped in the cart drop area in the parking lot post round.
