#### 2019 Program

## As a "Family Course Pass Holder" you receive the following benefits:

- 1. Able to play unlimited **9 hole rounds** on the "Family Course" (Level 1 or 2 tees) any day after 6:06pm. Pass is valid from May 10<sup>th</sup> through September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Tee times are based on availability
- 2. "New to the Game of Golf' Orientation Lesson Series (Includes 4, one hour complimentary group clinics- May 19th, May 26th, June 2nd & June 9th 4:30pm 5:30pm)
- **3.** 50% off club rentals throughout the season. Adult rentals-\$30 per round and junior rentals-\$15 per round.
- 4. All golf must be played as a family unit, meaning at least one child dependent (19 and under) must be present in the group for rounds played on the family course.

#### "New to the Game of Golf" Orientation Series

The orientation series will focus on getting novice golfers comfortable with golf etiquette and provide them with basic golf fundamentals in a fun and social format. The lessons include 4 complimentary group clinics covering golf etiquette, rules of golf, golf knowledge, and basic skill fundamentals.

#### **Golf Course Use**

- Family Course Pass holders may play after 6:06pm, any day of the week based on availability.
- Access to our practice facilities (driving range, putting green and chipping green) from 5:00pm on. Use these areas as a warm up before your round, no additional costs. Practice facility use outside off preround warm up can be purchased for \$20/hour per person (normal practice facility rate). Note that the driving range is closed every Thursday at 5:30pm for range maintenance.
- Dress code for play is collared shirts for men/boys, shirts with sleeves for ladies (sleeveless shirts must have a collar), and no denim for all players.
- Pass holders must check in at Golf Shop with their identification prior to teeing off. Pass holders are expected to display their bag tag during play.
- Golf may be played from only the Level 1 or Level 2 Family Tees. The majority of 9 hole rounds will be played on the front nine although there will be days where the back nine is available for play.
- Family pass groups will maintain their position on the golf course relative to other groups. We have set a realistic time goal to complete 9-hole rounds in 2 hours or less.
- Passes valid until September 8th (due to limited daylight).
- For safety reasons everyone must be off the golf course before sunset.
- Pass holders may book tee times up to 2 weeks in advance.
- Pass holders may have a maximum of 2 tee times in the system at any one time (i.e. 2 times per family)
- For better access to the golf course it is advised that Pass holders book a tee time in advance through online reservations.
